Ryan Fisher with H.D. Fowler Co. has taken on the challenge of organizing this year's golf tournament. He has decided this year's format will be Vegas Style. Here are the rules:

- ◆ Each team is issued one di to be used throughout the round.
  - ◆ Every person on the team is assigned a number (1,2,3, or 4) that will be their number for the round. AFTER every player has hit their tee shot at each hole, someone on the team will roll the di. Whosever number is rolled - is the drive that will be used. If a 5 is rolled, you must roll again. If a 6 is rolled, it is team choice - you can use anyone's drive.
  - ◆ You have the option of NOT using anyone's drive on consecutive holes. If a player's number is rolled on consecutive holes, you MAY roll again, until a different player's number is rolled.
  - ◆ Once a drive is determined it is a normal scramble through the rest of the hole.
  - ◆ No handicaps are used. Best score wins!
